Check Your fluids

My sister called and was telling me about how her power steering was making noise, and she had taken it to 2 different shops and they both told her she needed a new power steering rack. I told her to wait till I came down to visit to look at it. I took it down to Orielly auto parts to check everything. (needed a level surface, her house doesn't have level roads or driveway) and found that it was just low on fluid, I filled the power steering fluid and she hasn't had an issue or sound from it since. Basically nether place checked her power steering fluid.

My roommate recently was complaining that his transmission was going out, it was acting weird, not engaging then bam, it goes. He even asked at a shop what it could be, they said it could be the transmission, but would need to inspect to make sure.(they did not check the fluid) I asked if he had checked the fluids and he just looked at me funny, so I helped and showed him how to check it, and there was nothing on the stick. He went to the store and got 2 qts of trans fluid, I showed him the tiny tipped funnel made for trans tube and he added the fluid, it barely made it to the stick, but he said it is now working fine with no issues.(and yes, I told him to get another qt to fill to the line).

I was also having issues with my transmission not engaging the gears, it would take a minute ro switch from Reverse to Drive. so I figured I needed to check my fluids too, and found that it was low. So I added a qt and all was fine.

So now the first thing I ask when someone is having issues with their cars' is, "Have you check your fluids lately?"

The first is through Email, you might get an email that looks like it's from Norton, Symantec, B of A, Wells Fargo, your credit union, or any other company that you may or may not use. It'll state that your bank or credit card has been charged some amount, and if you have questions, call this number. It may look official, but it's usually Fake. **DO NOT REPLY OR CLICK ANYTHING** in the email. *It's A Trap*. In-





stead you should go directly to your bank or credit union, ether online, over the phone, or even in person, and ask them if there are any charges in the said amount. They understand and will help you if there is an issue. A dead giveaway that it's a scam is If they ask to be paid by money order, bitcoin, Wal-Mart gift card, or anything other then normal pay methods.

The next is direct calling. They will call you and say that their from Microsoft, HP, or another company that you've heard of, and that there's a problem with your computer or printer or something else. And they will convince you to let them connect to your computer to fix the issue, when they do, they gotcha! They can take your data, plant key trackers, or even lock you out of your PC. Then you have to pay to get it back, if your lucky. Just remember, the real company will never call you. The only time they would call you is if you called them first and left your number to call you back.


